This revelation is a promise from the Lord that He will provide temporal blessings and open the door of self-reliance, which is the ability for us to provide the necessities of life for ourselves and our family members.

President Dieter F. Uchtdorf taught, "Like two sides of a coin, the temporal and spiritual are inseparable" ("Providing in the Lord's Way," Ensign or Liahona, Nov. 2011, 53). In the scriptures, the Lord declared, "All things unto me are spiritual, and not at any time have I given unto you a law which was temporal" (D&C 29:34).

President Thomas S. Monson taught: "Let us be self-reliant and independent. Salvation can be obtained on no other principle" ("Guiding Principles of Personal and Family Welfare," Ensign, Sept. 1986, 3; quoting Marion G. Romney, in Conference Report, Oct. 1976, 167).

"The Church and its members are commanded by the Lord to be self-reliant and independent" (Teachings of Presidents of the Church: Spencer W. Kimball [2006], 116).

Jane Ziegler in the last Stake conference reminded us that obedience brings blessings! Tithing is paid with faith and obedience.

Malachi 3:10-12

10 Bring ye all the <u>tithes</u> into the storehouse, that there may be <u>meat</u> in mine house, and <u>prove me</u> <u>now herewith</u>, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not <u>open</u> you the <u>windows of heaven</u>, and pour you out a <u>blessing</u>, that *there shall* not *be room* enough *to receive it*.

11 And I will <u>rebuke</u> the <u>devourer</u> for your sakes, and <u>he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the Lord of hosts.

12 And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the Lord of hosts. This means you probably need to garden to have fruits and vines of the ground.</u>

Can you count the tithing blessings you have received? What about fast offering blessings?

Having been many church leadership meetings, I learned that the one item keeping most people out of the temple is tithing.

What about the food storage we've been asked to secure since the mid-1800's, about 175 years ago? We don't store food for ourselves, usually. We do it out of obedience and to help our neighbors through the bishops storehouse system.
